



#### Human settlement

For this purpose, people may erect houses and other structures and command some area or territory as their economic support-base.








#### Urban Area





#### Town



# City

 A city is a large <u>human settlement</u>. It can be defined as a permanent and <u>densely</u> settled place with administratively defined boundaries whose members work primarily on non-agricultural tasks



### Urbanisation

• Urbanization (or urbanisation) refers to the population shift from <u>rural</u> to <u>urban areas</u>, the corresponding decrease in the proportion of people living in rural areas, and the ways in which societies adapt to this change.



#### SUB URABANISATION



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
## **Urban Sprawl**

 urban sprawl, also called sprawl or suburban sprawl, the rapid expansion of the geographic extent of cities and towns, often characterized by low-density residential housing, single-use zoning, and increased reliance on the private automobile for transportation




#### Peri urban area

 Peri-urban areas are zones of transition from rural to urban land uses located between the outer limits of urban and regional centres and the rural environment. The boundaries of periurban areas are porous and transitory as urban development extends into rural and industrial land.



#### Central business district

 A central business district (CBD) is the commercial and business centre of a city. It contains commercial space and offices, and in larger cities will often be described as a <u>financial district</u>. Geographically, it often coincides with the "<u>city centre</u>" or "<u>downtown</u>"






# Trend of urbanisation at international level

Share of the urban population by continent in 1950 and 2020 (in percent)


